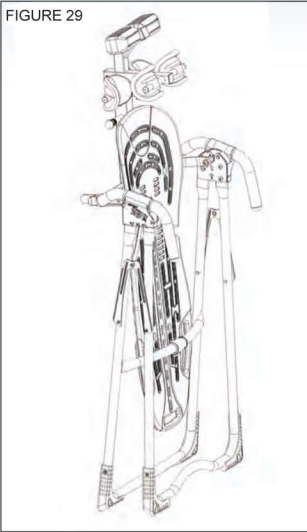

## Storage

- Remove the Angle Tether from the U-Bar located on the underside of the Table Bed.
- Pull the Height-Selector Locking Pin and slide the Main Shaft in all the way to the last hole setting.
- Release and engage the Pin in the storage setting.
- Rotate the Table Bed opposite from use until it has turned 180° and rests against the Crossbar of the A-Frame.
- Pull up on the Spreader Arms to fold the A-Frame (Figure 29), leaving the A-Frame legs open to a width of 12" for stability.

**NOTE:** This operation may pinch fingers if not done slowly and carefully.

### ⚠ WARNING

Tipping Hazard: For upright storage, leave A-frame open wide enough to remain stable, or secure to the wall to prevent tipping. In households with small children, the inversion table should be stored flat on the floor, not upright.



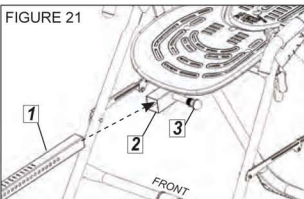
Folded dimensions:

In order to make **storage more easier**, you can disassemble your Teeter Hang Ups inversion table (EP-Series only) in 3 pieces before making a long move or placing them into storage. This allows the table to be stored in a smaller space and assists in the logistics of transportation.

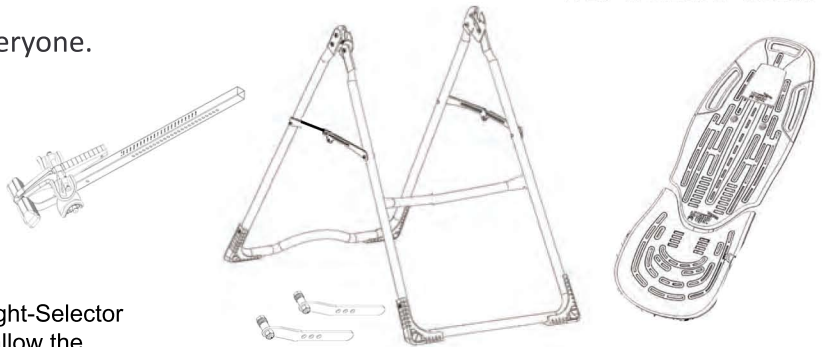
As a do-it-yourself, it's very easy for everyone.

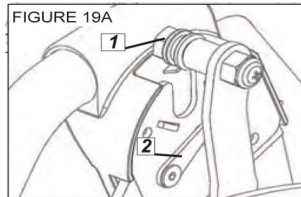


Pull out the Height-Selector Locking Pin to allow the Main Shaft to slide out from the Main Shaft Housing on the Table Bed.



### Step 2

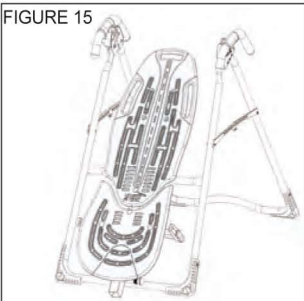

Pick up the Table Bed by releasing the Roller Hinges from the A-Frame hing plates.

### Step 3

Rest the Table Bed and open the Cam locks on each side and take off the Roller Hinges from the brackets



After disassembled, your Teeter Hang Ups inversion table can be store in a smaller space.
